What is the Role of the MINT Lead?

The MINT Lead will be a link from the MINT network to a geographical area within the United Kingdom (UK) whether this be a University and or a National Health Service (NHS) trust, private nursing services or armed forces.

The role will ask of you to advocate for the MINT in your current area in the way of educating and conversing with nursing students and Registered staff of all genders, races and creeds to promote and encourage diversity within the growing network. Sharing the ethos with individuals, placing posters in Universities, NHS Trusts or other areas that can potentially strengthen our growing voice.

Dependent on engagement of this role initially every 6-8 weeks we intend to ask for feedback of how you are getting on and the progress that you have made in each area, this can then be updated when and if changes have occurred in the area you are leading.

As the MINT is expanding, we are looking soon to expand our Admin numbers and form a committee to which MINT Leads have the option of becoming moderators of the Facebook page and members of the committee.

As with all members of MINT the leads must adhere to the rules set out on the MINT Facebook page and must always adhere to the Nursing and Midwifery Council's (NMC) code of conduct including the use of social media.
